## PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

The objective of the Pharmacy Technician program is to involve students in the technical knowledge and practical skills required for entry-level positions in retail pharmacies, hospital or HMO pharmacies, health-care providers, and pharmaceutical companies as a Registered Pharmacy Technicians.

The professional duties of a Pharmacy Technician may include: collecting, organizing and evaluating information for direct patient care; receiving and screening prescriptions / medication orders for completeness and authenticity; preparing medications for dispensing; verifying the measurements, preparation, or packaging of medication produced by other technicians; dispensing medications; assisting the pharmacist in monitoring medication therapy; and maintaining confidentiality of patient and proprietary business information.

Upon successful completion of the program requirements, graduates will be awarded a diploma. Although Glen Oaks College will assist students with job placement, finding employment is the individual responsibility of the student. The College does not guarantee that any student will be placed in any of the jobs described or placed at all.
